Springtime has been busy with HOA-managed activities:

- Making interim repairs to several roofs
- Power washing and painting trim for scheduled homes
- Testing and replacing sprinkler heads for lawn irrigation
- Scheduled lawn treatments and mowing
- Caulking around copper window sheathing

Once again, I'd like to thank the Roofing Committee (Bill Killorn, Mac Paulett, and Richard Brock) for their work and initiative leading to the roofing study and interim repairs. As a result of their work, we now know that all of the roofs are in good shape as we approach the 20-year lifetime at which roof replacements are scheduled to begin.

With flower gardens in bloom and trees filled out with leaves, the neighborhood is looking very nice. A major reason that MV stays beautiful is the work of our neighbors serving on committees. As we all know, homes and yards don't get better when left on their own - they need oversight and maintenance.

Have you ever considered volunteering to serve on an HOA committee? Volunteering is a great way to help ensure that MV remains a wonderful place to live, and much more rewarding than watching TV. ③

There are two types of committees: Standing and Temporary. The standing committees are the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) and Grounds Committee. Their work is ongoing, so they are permanent, although the committee members may change over time.

Temporary Committees research and make recommendations on specific issues. For example, when the brass lighting fixtures on our homes started to tarnish and develop electrical problems, the Lighting Committee, led by Roy Dahlquist, was formed to find suitable replacements and to establish guidelines for acquiring and installing the new fixtures. Once that work was done, the committee was disbanded.

If you'd like to learn more about serving on a committee, contact me or Roy. You may want to sit in on one or more committee meetings to see them in action before volunteering.

So far, this spring and early summer, the lawns are looking good. There are a few trouble spots, but I've met with Nature's Way and the homeowners to work towards a resolution of those issues. As we get into the peak summer heat in July and August we typically see some yellowing of the lawns. Depending on temperatures, wind, humidity, and rainfall it's hard to predict how things will play out but Nature's Way and Montgomery Irrigation will be doing what they can to keep the lawns looking good.
