Where needed, the inspectors replaced a few of the rubber "boots" surrounding the vent pipes. This was a quick and easy fix to prevent potential water damage before the roofs are completely replaced.

I look forward to serving you for my two-year term and appreciate your support. I am a "chronic" walker and walk around the neighborhood for exercise just about every day. Recently I've been making a point to introduce myself to neighbors that I haven't met - so don't be surprised if I walk up to you and say "Hi."

UPDATE THE APPEARANCE OF YOUR HOME WITH THE APPROVED NEW BRASS LIGHT FIXTURES

The current brass light fixtures on either side of the garage doors, at the rear/side door and at the front door are badly tarnished on most homes. Theses light fixtures have been discontinued.

Madison Village and Charter Colony have approved Progress BrassGUARD brass light fixtures as the official replacement fixtures.

These are the only replacement fixtures that are permitted.

These light fixtures can be seen at many of the homes on Shawhan Court.
