

Campaign Signs

As November approaches, the Foundation reminds residents that there are campaign signage regulations in Charter Colony. As stated in the Charter Colony guidelines, campaign signage is permitted only in the front yard, may not exceed 6 square feet and may not stand higher than 5' from the ground. Only one election sign (total) may be displayed per developed or underdeveloped lot in accordance with national, federal, local, or community elections. The sign may be displayed no more than 30 days prior to or 14 days following any election.

Planning on Removing Anything From Your Property?

Whether you are planning to add new items, make changes or remove existing landscaping <u>anywhere</u> on your property or install, improve or remove improvements, i.e., attic fans, awnings, dormers, landscaping walls, pergolas, storm doors, water features, etc. those changes must be submitted first to Madison Village for approval and later to Charter Colony for final approval.

September

- Aerate seed property
- Apply Virginia Certified Blue Tag seed at a rate of 4-5#/1000 sq. ft.
- Apply starter fertilizer (18-24-12) 30% slow release

October

Apply fertilizer (32-8-5) 30% slow release

NEW BOARD COMMITTEES

Street Tree Committee

At the April 26, 2022 meeting of the Madison Village Board of Directors, the Board voted to create a Street Tree Committee. The Committee's purpose:

- To review the current Street Tree policy and to recommend changes to address issues that have arisen due to the aging of the trees;
- To define the process by which homeowners may replace street trees;
- To forward to the Charter Colony Modification Committee the proposed changes to the Madison Village Addendum for review and approval.

The Street Tree Committee's Charter is posted to the Madison Village website.

Financial Advisory Committee

At the July 26, 2022 meeting of the Madison Village Board of Directors, the Board voted to create a Financial Advisory Committee. The Committee's purpose:

- To explore and evaluate investment options available to the HOA with the objective of maximizing interest earned on HOA investments;
- To present the committee's findings and to make investment recommendations to the Board.
